Sophomore Year

[What you can do now to take an active stance!]

 Focus on academics; take appropriate challenging classes and earn your best grades.
 Continue to read, read.
 Begin talking with college reps who visit the Elms in the fall.
 Attend college fairs.
 Take the practice PSAT [administered in October to all Elms sophomores] and consider a brief preparatory class.
 Begin thinking about personal interests, strengths, and possible college majors.
 Explore careers and their entrance requirements
 View college websites to look at curricula.
 Save your best work in academic courses; sometimes colleges ask to see it.
 Continue participation in activities both on and off campus.
 Volunteer to grow your character and apply your untapped skills.
 Continuously update your resume on Naviance.
 Attend (a) summer college program(s) to broaden your learning.
 Visit potential colleges during the summer between your sophomore and junior years.
 Use your summer to prepare for your junior year October PSAT, which qualifies students for National Merit status.
